

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 654—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Clark County for support of Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games. (BDR S-1691)

AN ACT making an appropriation to Clark County for the support of the Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 WHEREAS, The Inner-City Games began in Los Angeles in 1991 in
2 response to the growing problems facing inner-city youth, with Arnold
3 Schwarzenegger as the founder and Chairman; and

4 WHEREAS, In 1996, Las Vegas joined 11 other cities nationwide by
5 founding the Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games; and

6 WHEREAS, The Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games has been
7 supported solely by private sponsorships of cash or in-kind contributions;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, More than 10,000 Southern Nevada inner-city youth have
10 been positively affected each year through a program of sports, educational
11 and cultural activities, all of which are free of charge to all participants,
12 including transportation costs; now, therefore,

14 THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
15 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:
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17 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
18 Clark County the sum of \$250,000 for distribution to the nonprofit
19 organization Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games for the continuation of
20 sports, educational and cultural activities in the Greater Las Vegas area.

1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
3 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
4 committed have been made.

5 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
