

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 666—COMMITTEE ON TAXATION

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to off-track pari-mutuel wagering. (BDR 41-1656)

AN ACT relating to pari-mutuel wagering; revising the prohibition against rebates and incentives under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 464.075 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 464.075 1. A person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-
3 mutuel wagering shall not:
4 (a) Accept from a patron less than the full face value of an off-track
5 pari-mutuel wager;
6 (b) Agree to refund or rebate to a patron any portion or percentage of
7 the full face value of an off-track pari-mutuel wager; ~~or~~
8 (c) Increase the payoff of, or pay a bonus on, a winning off-track pari-
9 mutuel wager ~~or~~; ***or***
10 ***(d) Provide any other incentive,***
11 ***if the race upon which the wager is placed occurs in a jurisdiction that***
12 ***prohibits such an acceptance, agreement, increase or incentive.***
13 2. A person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel
14 wagering and who:
15 (a) Attempts to evade the provisions of subsection 1 by offering to a
16 patron a wager that is not posted and offered to all patrons; or
17 (b) Otherwise violates the provisions of subsection 1,

1 is subject to the investigatory and disciplinary proceedings that are set forth
2 in NRS 463.310 to 463.318, inclusive, and shall be punished as provided in
3 those sections.

4 3. The Nevada gaming commission shall adopt regulations to carry out
5 the provisions of this section.

6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
