AN ACT relating to the commission for the preservation of wild horses; authorizing the commission to retain the balance of an appropriation previously made to the commission to conduct a study of the feasibility of establishing a private foundation for the promotion of the public adoption of wild horses and burros; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11 of chapter 537, Statutes of Nevada 1997, at page 2537, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4 of NRS 504.450, there is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the director's office of the state department of conservation and natural resources the following sums for the purposes set forth in subsection 2:

- (a) For the fiscal year 1997-98......\$75,000
- (b) For the fiscal [year 1998-99] years 1998-0075,000
- 2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 must be allocated as follows [for each of the respective fiscal years:]:
- (a) For the fiscal year 1997-98:

(b) For the fiscal year 1998-99:

- (c) For the fiscal year 1999-00, any balance of the sum appropriated pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1 which has not been committed for expenditure on June 30, 1999, may be expended by the commission for the preservation of wild horses to conduct a study of the feasibility of establishing a private foundation for the promotion of the public adoption of wild horses and burros.
 - 3. Any balance of the [sums] sum appropriated by:
- (a) Paragraph (a) of subsection 1 remaining [at the end of the respective fiscal years] on June 30, 1998, must not be committed for expenditure after [June 30 of the respective fiscal year] that date and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

(b) Paragraph (b) of subsection 1 remaining on June 30, 2000, must not be committed for expenditure after that date and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
