AN ACT relating to prisons; authorizing travel expenses for certain persons employed at the Men's Prison No. 7; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 209.183 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 209.183 In addition to his regular salary, each person employed by the
3 department ~~[of prisons]~~ or the division of forestry of the state department of
4 conservation and natural resources at the Southern Nevada Correctional
5 Center, the Southern Desert Correctional Center, the Indian Springs
6 Conservation Camp, ***the correctional institution identified as the Men's***
7 ***Prison No. 7 in chapter 656, Statutes of Nevada 1995, and chapter 478,***
8 ***Statutes of Nevada 1997,*** or the proposed Jean Conservation Camp is
9 entitled to receive, as compensation for travel expenses, not more than \$6
10 for each day he reports to work if his residence is more than 25 miles from
11 the respective facility. The total cost for compensation for travel expenses
12 authorized by this section must not exceed the amount specially
13 appropriated for this purpose.
14 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
