

ASSEMBLY BILL No. 699—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

MAY 29, 1999

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Authorizes and provides funding for certain projects of capital improvement.

AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds of the state; requiring the repayment for certain projects by certain state agencies; authorizing certain expenditures by the State Public Works Board; levying a property tax to support the consolidated bond interest and redemption fund; making appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** The State Board of Finance shall issue general obligation
2 bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than
3 \$157,992,540 for the capital improvements summarized in this section.
4 This amount is allocated to projects numbered and described in the
5 executive budget for the fiscal years 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 or
6 otherwise described as follows:

35 Finance shall issue general
36 obligation
37 bonds of the State of Nevada in the face
38 amount of not more than \$407,649
39 for capital improvement project 99-C39L,
40 various general improvements at
41 the Old Las Vegas Mormon Fort, Phase
42 1B.
43 2. The proceeds of the bonds
44 issued pursuant to this section
45 must be
46 allocated to the State Department of
47 Conservation and Natural
48 Resources.
49 The State Department of Conservation and
50 Natural Resources shall

1 administer the project.

2 3. The Legislature finds and
3 declares that the issuance of bonds
4 pursuant to this section is necessary for the
5 protection and preservation of
6 the property of this state and for the
7 purpose of obtaining the benefits
8 thereof, and constitutes an exercise of the
9 authority conferred by the second
10 paragraph of section 3 of article 9 of the
11 Constitution of the State of
12 Nevada.

13 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance
14 of the allocated amounts
15 authorized in
16 sections 1 and 2 of this act must not be
17 committed for expenditure after
18 June 30, 2003, and reverts to the bond
19 interest and redemption account in
20 the consolidated bond interest and
21 redemption fund as soon as all
22 payments
23 of money committed have been made.

1 **Sec. 4.** 1. The State Controller may ad
2 state general fund, upon the approval of the
3 Chief of the Budget Division of
4 the Department of Administration, to the
5 State Public Works Board or the
6 State Department of Conservation and
7 Natural Resources, until the date
8 on
9 which bonds authorized by sections 1 and
10 2 of this act are sold, amounts
11 necessary to facilitate the start of the
12 projects enumerated in sections 1
13 and
14 2 of this act. The State Controller shall not
15 advance more than the face
16 amount of the bonds authorized to be
17 issued. The advanced amounts
18 must
19 be repaid immediately to the state general
20 fund upon the sale of the bonds.
21 2. The Chief of the Budget
22 Division of the Department of
23 Administration shall notify the State
24 Controller and the Fiscal Analysis
25 Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau
26 of the approval of an advance
27 from the state general fund to the State
28 Public Works Board or the State
29 Department of Conservation and Natural
30 Resources pursuant to subsection
31 1.
32 **Sec. 5.** 1. If the University and
33 Community College System of
34 Nevada determines that all or a portion of
35 the amounts allocated pursuant
36 to section 1 of this act for project 99-C16,
37 student development center,
38 TMCC, are not needed to complete the
39 project because there is sufficient
40 money available from other sources to
41 complete the project, the
42 University
43 and Community College System of Nevada
44 shall notify the State Public
45 Works Board of that determination in
46 writing. A notification provided
47 pursuant to this section must specify the
48 amount allocated pursuant to
49 section 1 of this act for project 99-C16 that
50 is not needed to complete the

1 project.

2 2. Upon the receipt of
3 notification from the University
4 and Community

5 College System of Nevada that all or a
6 portion of the amounts allocated
7 pursuant to section 1 of this act for project
8 99-C16, student development
9 center, TMCC, are not needed to complete
10 the project, the State Public
11 Works Board shall transfer the amount
12 specified in the notification to
13 support the Board in carrying out the
14 program of capital improvements
15 summarized in this section. The amount
16 specified in the notification must
17 be allocated in the manner prescribed in
18 this section to projects numbered
19 and described in the executive budget for
20 the fiscal years 1999-2000 and
21 2000-2001 or otherwise described as
22 follows:

29 appropriated pursuant to section 7
