AN ACT relating to the state militia; increasing the maximum allowable age for commissioned officers of the Nevada National Guard; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 412.026 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 412.026 1. The militia of the state is composed of the Nevada
- 3 National Guard and, when called into active service by the governor, the
- 4 Nevada National Guard Reserve and any volunteer organizations licensed
- 5 by the governor.
- 2. The Nevada National Guard is an organized body of enlisted
- personnel between the ages of 17 and 64 years and commissioned officers
- 8 between the ages of 18 and [62] 64 years, divided into the Nevada Army
- 9 National Guard and the Nevada Air National Guard.
- 10 3. The Nevada National Guard Reserve is an unorganized body
- 11 comprising all able-bodied residents of the state between the ages of 17
- 12 and 64 years who:
- (a) Are not serving in any force of the Nevada National Guard;
- (b) Are or have declared their intention to become citizens of the United
- 15 States: and
- (c) Are not exempted from military duty under the laws of this state or
- 17 the United States.

- 4. If a volunteer organization is formed and becomes licensed by the
- 2 governor, it shall consist of an organized body of able-bodied residents of 3 the state between the ages of 17 and 64 years who are not serving in any 4 force of the Nevada National Guard and who are or who have declared

- 5 their intention to become citizens of the United States.
- **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
