- 2 sad passing of former Nevada Legislator Max J. Bennett on September 19,
- 3 1998; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Max Bennett was born in the town of Duncan, Oklahoma,
- 5 on July 10, 1952; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Max Bennett attended East Central University in Ada,
- 7 Oklahoma, and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in mathematics and
- 8 in physics; and
- 9 WHEREAS, After moving to Nevada, Max Bennett joined the Clark
- 10 County Republican Party Central Committee, served on its Executive
- 11 Committee and was honored in 1994 with the Clark County GOP
- 12 “Leadership Award”; and

1 WHEREAS, In 1994, Max Bennett was elected to the Nevada Legislature
2 to represent Assembly District No. 14; and

3 WHEREAS, During Max Bennett's term in the 68th session of the
4 Nevada Legislature, he received praise for his sincerity and hard work as a
5 member of the Assembly Standing Committees on Education and on
6 Government Affairs, in addition to his service as a Vice Chairman on the
7 Assembly Standing Committee on Natural Resources, Agriculture and
8 Mining; and

9 WHEREAS, One of Max Bennett's special interests was working with the
10 Department of Education's Educational Outreach Program; and

11 WHEREAS, Former Assemblyman Max Bennett is survived by two
