- 3 Counsel Bureau provide services to the Legislature which are vital to an
- 4 efficient and productive session of the Nevada Legislature; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The additional employees hired specifically for the
- 6 legislative session also provide essential services with dedication,
- 7 competence and enthusiasm throughout the long days of the session; and
- 8 WHEREAS, With the recently adopted 120-day limit on the length of the
- 9 legislative session, the entire legislative staff has worked diligently to meet

1 required deadlines further demonstrating their extraordinary talents,
2 patience, flexibility and tireless work ethic; and

3 WHEREAS, The members of the 70th session of the Nevada Legislature
4 do hereby recognize and express their appreciation of the outstanding

17 (b) If requested to do so by the employee's supervisor, remains in that
18 employment after the last day of this session until all tasks assigned to the
19 employee during the session are completed.
