AN ACT making an appropriation to the Clark County School District for clerical resources to track and report irregularities of the attendance and truancy of pupils; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Clark County School District for clerical resources to assist in tracking and reporting irregularities in the attendance and truancy of pupils:

For the fiscal year 1999-2000 \$2,769,452 For the fiscal year 2000-2001 \$2,769,452

2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 must be used only to pay for the salaries and benefits of the clerical and support staff who are hired by

- the Clark County School District to assist schools within the Clark County
- School District with tracking and reporting irregularities in the attendance
- 12 and truancy of pupils for purposes of NRS 385.347, 392.130, 392.140 and
- 13 392.142.

- 3. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for either fiscal year. Any balance remaining of those sums must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
