SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Department of Transportation for construction of sound barriers on McCarran Boulevard between Pyramid Way and Baring Boulevard. (BDR S-394)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Transportation for the construction of sound barriers on McCarran Boulevard between Pyramid Way and Baring Boulevard; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the Department of Transportation the sum of \$590,000 for the construction
3 of sound barriers on both sides of McCarran Boulevard between Pyramid
4 Way and Baring Boulevard, a distance of approximately 9,600 feet.
5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
6 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after the project is
7 completed and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of
8 money committed have been made.
9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
