AN ACT relating to roads; requiring Clark County to provide for certain U-turns on West Desert Inn Road in Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. The board of county commissioners of Clark County
- shall, as soon as practicable, take all actions necessary to cause appropriate
- 3 openings or crossing places, and all other necessary modifications to
- 4 existing traffic lanes, signs and signals, to be made on West Desert Inn
- 5 Road, approximately 660 feet east of Valley View Boulevard, in Las
- 6 Vegas, sufficient to allow both eastbound and westbound vehicles on West
- 7 Desert Inn Road to make a U-turn safely at that location.
- 8 2. As used in this section, "U-turn" has the meaning ascribed to it in
- 9 NRS 484.216.
- Sec. 2. The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to
- any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
- 12 provisions of this act.
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
