SUMMARY—Requires Clark County to provide for certain U-turns on West Desert Inn Road in Las Vegas. (BDR S-158)

AN ACT relating to roads; requiring Clark County to provide for certain U-turns on West Desert Inn Road in Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. The board of county commissioners of Clark County
2 shall, as soon as practicable, take all actions necessary to cause appropriate
3 openings or crossing places, and all other necessary modifications to
4 existing traffic lanes, signs and signals, to be made on West Desert Inn
5 Road, approximately 660 feet east of Valley View Boulevard, in Las
6 Vegas, sufficient to allow both eastbound and westbound vehicles on West
7 Desert Inn Road to make a U-turn safely at that location.
8 2. As used in this section, “U-turn” has the meaning ascribed to it in
9 NRS 484.216.
10 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to
11 any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
12 provisions of this act.
13 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
