AN ACT relating to biological weapons; prohibiting the development, production, stockpiling, transfer, acquisition, retention or possession of a biological agent, toxin or delivery system in certain circumstances; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 202 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A person who knowingly develops, produces, stockpiles, transfers, acquires, retains or possesses a biological agent, toxin or delivery system for use as a weapon, or who knowingly assists an organization to do so, is
- 6 guilty of a category A felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in 7 the state prison:
- 8 (a) For life with the possibility of parole, with eligibility for parole beginning when a minimum of 10 years has been served; or
- 10 (b) For a definite term of 25 years, with eligibility for parole beginning when a minimum of 10 years has been served.
- 12 2. As used in this section:
- (a) "Biological agent" has the meaning ascribed to it in 18 U.S.C. § 14 178.
- 15 (b) "Delivery system" has the meaning ascribed to it in 18 U.S.C. § 16 178.
- (c) "Toxin" has the meaning ascribed to it in 18 U.S.C. § 178.
- 3. As used in this section, the term "for use as a weapon" does not
- 19 include the development, production, transfer, acquisition, retention or

- possession of a biological agent, toxin or delivery system for prophylactic,
  protective or other peaceful purposes.
  Sec. 2. The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to acts that
  are committed before October 1, 1999.
