SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Eighth Judicial District Court for continuation of program of treatment for abuse of alcohol or drugs by certain persons. (BDR S-262)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Eighth Judicial District Court for the continuation of its program of treatment for abuse of alcohol or drugs by certain persons; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
2 fund to the Administrator of the Courts of the Eighth Judicial District of the
3 State of Nevada the sum of \$700,000 for the continuation of its program of
4 treatment for the abuse of alcohol or drugs by certain persons established
5 pursuant to NRS 453.580.
6 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used to
7 supplement and not to support or cause to be reduced any other source of
8 funding for the program of treatment established in the Eighth Judicial
9 District pursuant to NRS 453.580.
10 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
11 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
12 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
13 committed have been made.

1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.

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
