AN ACT relating to physicians; authorizing the board of medical examiners to issue a limited license to practice medicine in this state under certain circumstances to physicians who are licensed in certain other jurisdictions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 630 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a 1 new section to read as follows:
- Except as otherwise provided in NRS 630.161, the board may issue a limited license to practice medicine to an applicant who is licensed as a
- physician and in good standing in any state or territory of the United
- States, or in the District of Columbia, to enable the physician to come
- 7 into this state from time to time solely to evaluate and provide medical
- services to a child under the age of 18 years in connection with medical
- treatment that has been or may be provided to the child at a nonprofit
- hospital that is:
- (a) Located outside of this state; and 11
- (b) Operated by a charitable organization. 12
- 2. A physician who wishes to obtain a limited license to practice 13
- 14 medicine pursuant to this section:
- (a) Must submit an application to the board on a form approved by 15
- 16 the board;

- (b) Must pay to the secretary-treasurer of the board the applicable fee for the issuance of a limited license; and
- (c) Notwithstanding any specific statute to the contrary, is not subject to any other requirements for licensure set forth in this chapter or the regulations adopted pursuant thereto.
- 5. The board may issue such a limited license for not more than 2 years but may renew the license.
- 8 4. The board may revoke a limited license granted pursuant to this 9 section at any time for any of the grounds provided in NRS 630.161 or 10 630.301 to 630.3065, inclusive.
- 5. As used in this section, "charitable organization" means an organization that:
- (a) The Secretary of the Treasury has determined to be tax exempt pursuant to the provisions of section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code; and
- 16 (b) Holds a current certificate of organization or is currently qualified by the secretary of state to do business in this state.
