SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to National Judicial College for Death Penalty Resource Center to provide education and training regarding laws relating to capital punishment. (BDR S-1504)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the National Judicial College for the Death Penalty Resource Center to provide education and training regarding the laws relating to capital punishment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the National Judicial College the sum of \$120,000 for the Death Penalty
- 3 Resource Center to provide education and training for judges, prosecutors
- 4 and defense attorneys regarding the laws relating to capital punishment.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- 6 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
- 7 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 8 committed have been made.
- 9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
