AN ACT relating to trade regulation; prohibiting the refusal to sell fireworks to certain persons; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 597 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A wholesale dealer of fireworks shall not refuse to sell fireworks to a buyer if the buyer can satisfactorily demonstrate that:
- (a) He has conformed to all applicable federal, state and local laws relating to the purchase, sale, use, storage and possession of such fireworks; and
- 8 (b) He has the financial capability to pay for the fireworks with cash, a 9 cash equivalent or credit.
- 10 2. \bar{A} person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- Sec. 2. NRS 244.367 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 12 244.367 The board of county commissioners shall have power and
- jurisdiction in their respective counties to pass ordinances prohibiting,
- restricting, suppressing or otherwise regulating the sale, use, storage and
- possession of fireworks, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.
- Such an ordinance must not be inconsistent with section 1 of this act.
- 17 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
