SUMMARY—Requires administrator of division of state parks of state department of conservation and natural resources to charge and collect fee from person who rides motorcycle or bicycle into state park. (BDR 35-1192)

AN ACT relating to state parks; requiring the administrator of the division of state parks of the state department of conservation and natural resources to charge and collect a fee from each person who rides a motorcycle or bicycle into a state park; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 407 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. The administrator shall charge and collect a fee of \$5 per day from each person who rides a motorcycle or bicycle into a state park.

5 2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 407.0762, the fees collected 6 pursuant to this section must be deposited in the state general fund.

Sec. 2. NRS 407.0762 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 407.0762 1. The account for maintenance of state parks within the

9 division of state parks is hereby created in the state general fund. Except as

otherwise provided in NRS 407.0765, any amount of fees collected

pursuant to subsection 4 of NRS 407.065 and section 1 of this act in a

calendar year, [which is in excess of] that exceeds the amounts authorized

13 for expenditure from [that revenue source] those sources of revenue in the

14 [division's] budget of the division for the fiscal year beginning in that

calendar year, must be deposited in the account. The interest and income

earned on the money in the account, after deducting any applicable charges,

17 must be credited to the account.

- 2. The money in the account does not lapse to the state general fund at the end of any fiscal year.
- 3. The money deposited in the account pursuant to subsection 1 must only be used to repair and maintain state parks, monuments and recreational areas.
- 4. Before the administrator may expend money pursuant to subsection3:
- 8 (a) For emergency repairs, he must **[first]** receive the approval of the director.
- 10 (b) For purposes other than emergency repairs, he must [first] receive 11 the approval of the director and of the interim finance committee.

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
