AN ACT making an appropriation for the improvement and expansion of the China Spring Youth Camp; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the interim finance committee for distribution to Douglas County the sum
- 3 of \$2,800,000 for improvements to and the expansion of the China Spring
- 4 Youth Camp including:
- 5 1. The construction of a new 24-bed female juvenile dormitory;
- 6 2. The construction of a new 40-bed male juvenile dormitory;
  - 3. The construction of an administration building; and
- 4. Improvements to the septic system to handle the increased
- 9 population.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** The interim finance committee shall distribute to Douglas
- 11 County an amount equal to the actual cost for the work performed up to the
- amount appropriated pursuant to section 1 of this act after it receives a
- 13 report from Douglas County of the work performed and the actual cost for
- 14 that work.
- 15 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- of this act must not be committed for expenditure after the projects are
- 17 completed and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of
- 18 money committed have been made.

**Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
