THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 484.771 is hereby amended to read as follows: 1

484.771 1. [No vehicle shall] A vehicle must not be driven or moved 2

on any highway unless [such] the vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to

prevent any of its load from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise

escaping therefrom, except that sand may be dropped for the purpose of

securing traction, or water or other substance may be sprinkled on a

roadway in cleaning or maintaining [such] the roadway.

- [No person shall] A person shall not operate on any highway [any] a vehicle with [any] a load unless the load and any covering thereon is
- securely fastened so as to prevent the covering or load from becoming
- loose, detached or in any manner a hazard to other users of the highway.
- 12 The provisions of this section do not require a load on a vehicle to
- be covered. 13
