SUMMARY—Makes supplemental appropriation to fund for class-size reduction for additional anticipated expenses. (BDR S-1443)

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AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the fund for class-size reduction for additional anticipated expenses; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND  
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1    **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to  
2    the fund for class-size reduction, created by NRS 388.730, the sum of  
3    \$15,440,452 for additional anticipated expenses. This appropriation is  
4    supplemental to that made by section 2 of chapter 245, Statutes of Nevada  
5    1997, at page 868.

6    **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the supplemental appropriation  
7    made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
8    June 30, 1999, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments  
9    of money committed have been made.

10   **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
