AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety for the purchase of modular furniture for the remodeled office in Carson City; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund
2 to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of
3 \$1,185,476 for the purchase of modular furniture for the remodeled office
4 in Carson City.

5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
6 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
7 reverts to the state highway fund as soon as all payments of money
8 committed have been made.

9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
