THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 389.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

 (b) Origin and history of the constitutions [and the study]; and
 (c) Study of and devotion to American institutions and ideals.
- 2. The instruction required [in] by subsection 1 must be given during at least 1 year of the elementary school grades and for a period of at least 1
- year in all high schools.
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
