AN ACT relating to gates that provide access for vehicular traffic; requiring that certain gates comply with certain safety standards; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 405 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a
2 new section to read as follows:
3 ***A gate that:***
4 1. ***Operates by electrical power;***
5 2. ***Provides access for vehicular traffic; and***
6 3. ***Is installed on or after March 1, 2000,***
7 ***must comply with the requirements of the Underwriters Laboratories Inc.***
8 ***Standard for Safety 325, as published on September 18, 1998, and***
9 ***effective on March 1, 2000.***
10 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on March 1, 2000.

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
