AN ACT relating to state financial administration; revising the provisions governing the National College of Juvenile and Family Law Endowment; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the National College of Juvenile and Family Law the sum of
- 3 \$303,600 to assist in securing public and private grants and other funding
- 4 for support during the 1999-2001 biennium.
- 5 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 6 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and reverts to
- 7 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 8 been made.
- 9 **Sec. 2.** On June 30, 1999, the state controller shall transfer the sum of
- \$2,500,000 from the fund for the National College of Juvenile and Family
- Law, created by NRS 1.480, to the state general fund.
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
