AN ACT relating to state facilities; requiring the state to pay the connection fees for the connection of state buildings and other facilities to the sewage system of Carson City; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. Notwithstanding any restrictions on the authority of
- 2 Carson City to which Carson City has agreed pursuant to paragraph (c) of
- 3 subsection 2 of section 1 of chapter 503, Statutes of Nevada 1959, at page
- 4 907, a state agency or other state entity that controls a state building or
- 5 other facility which becomes connected to the sewage system of Carson
- 6 City on or after July 1, 2001, shall pay, at the same rate and time, the
- 7 connection fee that Carson City charges other users of the sewage system.
- 2. As used in this section, "state building or other facility" means a
- 9 building or other facility that is the property of the State of Nevada,
- o including, without limitation, a building or other facility that is the property
- of the University and Community College System of Nevada.
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
