THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a
- 2 new section to read as follows:
 - A governmental entity and any agent thereof shall not use
- 4 photographic, video or digital equipment for gathering evidence to be
- 5 used for the issuance of a traffic citation for a violation of this chapter
- 6 unless the equipment is held in the hand or installed temporarily or
- 7 permanently within a vehicle or facility of a law enforcement agency.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
