SUMMARY—Prohibits governmental entity and any agent thereof from using certain electronic devices to gather evidence for issuance of traffic citation. (BDR 43-504)

AN ACT relating to traffic; prohibiting a governmental entity and any agent thereof from using certain electronic devices to gather evidence for the issuance of a traffic citation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 484 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a
2 new section to read as follows:

3 *A governmental entity and any agent thereof shall not use*
4 *photographic, video or digital equipment for gathering evidence to be*
5 *used for the issuance of a traffic citation for a violation of this chapter*
6 *unless the equipment is held in the hand or installed temporarily or*
7 *permanently within a vehicle or facility of a law enforcement agency.*

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 1999.
