AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Transportation for use with federal money for transportation programs for elderly persons and persons with disabilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND
ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the Department of Transportation the sum of \$300,000 for use with federal
3 money received pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §§ 5310 and 5311, for operating
4 costs and the purchase of paratransit vehicles for transportation programs
5 for elderly persons and persons with disabilities.
6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
7 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and
8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
9 committed have been made.
10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
