## SENATE BILL NO. 423-SENATOR SCHNEIDER

SUMMARY—Requires contractors to give notice to owner of availability of warranty for roof. (BDR 54-1479)

AN ACT relating to contractors; requiring contractors to give notice to an owner of the availability of a warranty for a roof he constructs, installs, improves, alters or repairs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY. DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 624 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A contractor who constructs, installs, improves, alters or repairs a roof shall provide a dated written statement on which the contractor and owner are identified and which indicates in a clear and conspicuous manner, without limitation:
- (a) Whether a warranty on the roof exists; and
- (b) The number of years the warranty remains in effect, if a warranty exists.
- 10 2. The statement must have a space for the owner to indicate the 11 reason that:
- 12 (a) A new roof was installed; or
- 13 (b) The roof was repaired.
  - 4 3. The contractor shall provide the statement or a copy of the
- 15 statement to the owner upon completion of the work performed on the 16 roof.
- 17 4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, the contractor shall
- 18 give the owner of the roof a warranty on the roof for the number of years
- 19 indicated in the statement, if any are so indicated, regardless of whether

the terms of a construction contract or a separate written warranty
conflict.

- 5. If the statement fails to indicate whether a warranty exists or the number of years the warranty remains in effect, or if the owner fails to indicate on the statement the reason the contractor performed work on the roof, including, without limitation, the location of any leaks in the roof, the contractor shall be deemed to have given the owner a warranty for:
- 9 (a) The length of time that the material used to construct, install, 10 improve, alter or repair the roof is warranted by the manufacturer; or
- 11 (b) If the contractor, through no fault of his own, cannot determine 12 the length of time that the material used to construct, install, improve, 13 alter or repair the roof is warranted by the manufacturer, 10 years.

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
