AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
2 fund to the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service the
3 sum of \$125,000 for continuation of its programs dedicated to promoting
4 citizen volunteerism.
- 5 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the
6 Nevada Commission for National and Community Service obtaining
7 matching money from the Federal Government. The Nevada Commission
8 for National and Community Service shall submit a certification or other
9 proof satisfactory to the State Controller that the matching money has been
10 committed by the Federal Government before the money appropriated by
11 subsection 1 may be distributed.
- 12 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
13 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and reverts to
14 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
15 been made.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
