AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service the sum of \$125,000 for continuation of its programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism.
- 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service obtaining matching money from the Federal Government. The Nevada Commission
- 8 for National and Community Service shall submit a certification or other
- 9 proof satisfactory to the State Controller that the matching money has been
- committed by the Federal Government before the money appropriated by subsection 1 may be distributed.
- 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and reverts to
- the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 15 been made.
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
