SUMMARY—Requires Clark County School District to establish pilot program for educational programs of special emphasis. (BDR S-701)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the Clark County School District to establish a pilot program for educational programs of special emphasis; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. 1. The Clark County School District shall establish a pilot program for educational programs of special emphasis.
- The pilot program may include, without limitation, the establishment
- of courses of study and curricula at certain public schools within the Clark
- 5 County School District that:

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- (a) Emphasize a particular area, field or topic of instruction; or
- (b) Are taught in accordance with a particular method of instruction.
- 3. The educational programs of special emphasis established pursuant
- 9 to this section may be designed, without limitation, to:
- (a) Respond to the needs of both pupils and business and industry by
- using innovative instruction which is academically challenging to prepare
- pupils to enter into vocations that are projected to require large numbers of
- 13 new employees in the future.
- (b) Promote choice in education to foster academic excellence and
- 15 achievement and reform of the educational system.

- (c) Maintain continuity in educational programs of special emphasis through elementary, middle and high school.
- (d) Establish measurable goals of achievement, including, without limitation, those established pursuant to the Goals 2000: Educate America Act, 20 U.S.C. §§ 5801 et seq.
 - The Clark County School District shall:

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- (a) Ensure that the success of the pilot program for educational programs of special emphasis is evaluated at least once each year by an independent evaluator; and
- (b) On or before December 31 of each year, submit to the state board of 10 education the contents of the evaluation conducted pursuant to paragraph (a), accompanied by any additional materials that the school district 12 determines to be relevant. 13
 - The State Board of Education shall prepare a report on its findings with respect to the evaluations and materials that the board receives pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 4 and shall, on or before February 1, 2001, submit a copy of the report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 71st session of the Nevada Legislature.
- 19 Sec. 2. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to 20 the Clark County School District for the support of the pilot program for 21 educational programs of special emphasis: 22
- For the fiscal year 1999-2000.....\$1,600,000 For the fiscal year 2000-2001.....\$1,600,000 24
- The money appropriated pursuant to this section: 25
 - (a) Must be used at schools within the Clark County School District to:
 - (1) Develop and establish educational programs of special emphasis that are available to pupils throughout the school district;
 - (2) Purchase equipment and supplies for use in educational programs of special emphasis; and
- (3) Supplement, but not replace, the money that the schools would otherwise expend for educational programs of special emphasis in the 32 absence of this appropriation. 33
- (b) Must not be used to settle or arbitrate disputes or negotiate 34 settlements between an organization that represents licensed employees of 35 the school district and the school district. 36
- Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 37 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2001, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have 39 40 been made.
- **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval. 41
