AN ACT relating to gaming; exempting a proposed establishment that is located in a historic building from certain requirements pertaining to the issuance of a nonrestricted license in certain counties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE
AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 463.1605 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 463.1605 1. Except as otherwise provided in ~~subsection 3,~~ ***this***
3 ***section,*** the commission shall not approve a nonrestricted license, other
4 than for the operation of a race book or sports pool at an establishment
5 which holds a nonrestricted license to operate both gaming devices and a
6 gambling game, for an establishment in a county whose population is
7 100,000 or more unless the establishment is a resort hotel.
8 2. A county, city or town may require resort hotels to meet standards in
9 addition to those required by this chapter as a condition of issuance of a
10 gaming license by the county, city or town.
11 3. The commission may approve a nonrestricted license for an
12 establishment which is not a resort hotel at a new location if the
13 establishment was acquired or displaced pursuant to a redevelopment
14 project undertaken by an agency created pursuant to NRS 279.382 to
15 279.685, inclusive.

- 1 **4. The commission may approve a nonrestricted license for an**
- 2 **establishment that is not a resort hotel if the establishment is located in a**
- 3 **building which was historically used for the purpose of gaming and**
- 4 **which is or has been:**
- 5 **(a) Listed on the National Register of Historic Places; and**
- 6 **(b) Included on the list issued by the National Trust for Historic**
- 7 **Preservation of the 11 Most Endangered Historic Places.**
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
