AN ACT relating to state contracts; requiring the state board of examiners to approve a contract with more than one airline to provide transportation services to state officers and employees under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 281 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a

3 new section to read as follows:

If the state board of examiners approves a contract with an airline to provide transportation services for state officers and employees, it shall approve at least one additional contract with another airline to provide those services if:

- 1. The transportation services are available from more than one airline; and
- 2. The cost charged to the state under the additional contract or contracts is comparable to the cost charged to the state under the contract that was first approved.
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
