SUMMARY—Revises composition of commission on mental health and developmental services. (BDR 18-1166)

AN ACT relating to the commission on mental health and developmental services; revising the composition of the commission to include a marriage and family therapist; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** NRS 232.303 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 232.303 1. There is hereby created in the department a commission 2
- 3 on mental health and developmental services consisting of [seven] eight
- members appointed by the governor, at least three of whom have training or
- experience in dealing with mental retardation. 5
 - The governor shall appoint:
 - (a) A psychiatrist licensed to practice medicine in this state, from a list of three candidates submitted by the Nevada Psychiatric Association;
- (b) A psychologist licensed to practice in this state and experienced in
- clinical practice, from a list of four candidates, two of whom are submitted
- by the Northern Nevada Association for Certified Psychologists and two of
- whom are submitted by the Southern Society for Certified Psychologists; 12
- (c) A physician, other than a psychiatrist, licensed to practice medicine 13
- in this state and who has experience in dealing with mental retardation,
- from a list of three candidates submitted by the Nevada State Medical
- Association;
- (d) A social worker who has a master's degree and has experience in 17
- dealing with mental illness or mental retardation. or both:

- (e) A registered nurse licensed to practice in this state who has experience in dealing with mental illness or mental retardation, or both, from a list of three candidates submitted by the Nevada Nurses Association;
- (f) A marriage and family therapist licensed to practice in this state, from a list of three candidates submitted by the Nevada Association for Marriage and Family Therapy;
- (g) A representative of the general public who has a special interest in the field of mental health; and
- 9 (h) A representative of the general public who has a special interest in the field of mental retardation.
- 11 3. The governor shall appoint the chairman of the commission from among its members.

4. After the initial terms, each member shall serve a term of 4 years. If a vacancy occurs during a member's term, the governor shall appoint a person qualified under this section to replace that member for the remainder of the unexpired term.
