SUMMARY—Honors Chinese journalist Gao Yu. (BDR R-1153)

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Honoring Chinese journalist Gao Yu.

- 1 WHEREAS, Gao Yu, a well-known Chinese journalist, was one of the
- 2 first intellectuals to support students at Tiananmen Square in China; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In 1989, Gao Yu was involved in mediation between
- 4 students and the authorities in China during the pro-democracy movement
- 5 in Tiananmen Square and was one of the first intellectuals to be detained;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, In October, 1993, Gao Yu was apprehended by the Beijing
- 8 State Security 2 days before she was due to leave China for a fellowship at
- 9 Columbia University in New York; and
- 10 WHEREAS, This outstanding 52-year-old woman was not allowed to
- 11 have representation by her attorneys, her husband was not notified of her
- 12 apprehension and the verdict of spying and illegally providing state secrets
- 13 in articles for a Hong Kong magazine which was entered in November
- 14 1994, caused her to receive a sentence of 6 years in prison; and
- 15 WHEREAS, While the information reportedly obtained by Gao Yu may
- 16 have been confidential, there is no indication or evidence in the court
- 17 verdict that it concerned matters of national security; and
- 18 WHEREAS, In her appeal to the Beijing Higher People's Court, Gao Yu
- 19 maintained that her detention and trial were political and stated that the
- 20 contents of the documents which she was accused of leaking did not
- 21 contain state secrets; and

1 WHEREAS, During this period in detention, Gao Yu is reported to have
2 developed heart and kidney conditions, from which she is said to be still
3 suffering; and

4 WHEREAS, Because of Gao Yu's serious medical conditions, she was
5 recently released from prison, but continues to be on parole; now,
6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE ASSEMBLY
8 CONCURRING, That the members of the Nevada Legislature do hereby
9 honor Gao Yu for her courage and determination to fight for the ideals of
10 democracy; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That Las Vegas entertainers Malu-Lani and Maka-Koa are
12 hereby commended for their support of Gao Yu which they continue to
13 demonstrate by dedicating one song to Gao Yu at most of their
14 performances; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and transmit a copy
16 of this resolution to Malu-Lani and Maka-Koa.
