- 1 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA.
- 2 JOINTLY, That section 1 of article 4 of the Constitution of the State of
- 3 Nevada be amended to read as follows:
- Section [1. The Legislative authority of this State shall be vested in
- 5 a Senate and Assembly which shall be designated "The Legislature of the
- 6 State of [Nevada" and the] Nevada." The sessions of such Legislature shall
- 7 be held at the seat of government of the State ... of Nevada, except that the
- 8 Legislature may convene for not more than 20 days during any session at
- 9 such other places in this state as the Legislature may designate.
