SENATE RESOLUTION—Inducting T. Tracy Fairchild into the Senate Hall of Fame.

- 1 WHEREAS, The Senate of the Legislature of the State of Nevada has
- 2 established a Senate Hall of Fame whose members are selected by
- 3 leadership from former state Senators who have served with distinction
- 4 with exemplary contributions to the State of Nevada; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Tracy Fairchild, a leader in the Republican Party in Elko
- 6 County and this state, served in the Nevada Legislature with distinction and
- 7 fairness for 18 years as an Assemblyman from 1914 through 1918 and 1920
- 8 through 1922, as a Senator from 1922 through 1934, and as President Pro-
- 9 Tempore of the Senate in 1929; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Former Senator Fairchild was Chairman of the Senate
- 11 Standing Committee on Ways and Means for every legislative session he
- 12 served as a Senator and was instrumental in establishing tax levies,
- 13 providing appropriations for the operation of government, adopting
- 14 biennial state budgets and setting the salaries of state officers and
- 15 employees; now, therefore, be it
- 16 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That T. Tracy
- 17 Fairchild, a powerful and influential leader who set many of the fiscal
- 18 policies for the State of Nevada, is hereby inducted into the Senate Hall of
- 19 Fame of the Legislature of the State of Nevada.

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
