AN ACT making an appropriation to the City of Las Vegas for grants to support educational and recreational programs for children after the regularly scheduled school days and on weekends; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the City of Las Vegas the sum of \$1,000,000 for grants to support educational and recreational programs for children after the regularly scheduled school days and on weekends.
- 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
  - 3. The City of Las Vegas shall:

- 10 (a) Establish and maintain records concerning the use of the money 11 appropriated by subsection 1 which conform to generally accepted 12 accounting practices; and
  - (b) Provide a written report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the Legislative Commission on or before January 1, 2003, which clearly describes the expenditures made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 and their benefit to the state.
    - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
