AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the restoration of the historic Belmont Court House; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$125,000 for the restoration of the foundation and other portions necessary to preserve the structure of the 5 historic Belmont Court House.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and 8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

10 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
