AN ACT making an appropriation to Clark County for the support of the Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA. REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to Clark County the sum of \$100,000 for the support of the Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth.
- 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
  - The Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth shall:
- (a) Establish and maintain records concerning the use of the money appropriated by subsection 1 which conform to generally accepted 10 accounting practices; and 11
  - (b) Provide a written report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the Legislative Commission on or before January 1, 2003, which clearly describes the expenditures made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 and their benefit to the state.
