AN ACT making an appropriation to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for the establishment and operation of a center for the analysis of crime statistics within the Department of Criminal Justice at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to  
2     the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for the establishment and operation  
3     of a center for the analysis of crime statistics within the Department of  
4     Criminal Justice at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas:  
5         For the fiscal year 2001-2002..... \$179,000  
6         For the fiscal year 2002-2003..... \$140,000  
7     **Sec. 2.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are available for  
8     either fiscal year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for  
9     expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as  
10    soon as all payments of money committed have been made.  
11    **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
