AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; increasing the penalty for providing an alcoholic beverage to an underage person; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 202.055 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 202.055 1. Every person who knowingly:

3 (a) Sells, gives or otherwise furnishes an alcoholic beverage to any
4 person under 21 years of age;

5 (b) Leaves or deposits any alcoholic beverage in any place with the
6 intent that it will be procured by any person under 21 years of age; or

7 (c) Furnishes, gives, or causes to be given any money or thing of value
8 to any person under 21 years of age with the knowledge that the money or
9 thing of value is to be used by the person under 21 years of age to purchase
10 or procure any alcoholic beverage,
11 is guilty of a *gross* misdemeanor.

12 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection 1 does not apply to a parent, guardian or
13 physician of the person under 21 years of age.

14 **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses
15 committed before October 1, 2001.
