THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Chapter 235 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a
2 new section to read as follows:
3 *The march entitled “Silver State Fanfare,” composed by Gerald Willis,*
4 *is hereby adopted and declared to be the official state march of the State*
5 *of Nevada.*
