AN ACT relating to fiscal notes for legislative measures; requiring a fiscal note to contain an estimate of certain fiscal impacts for two biennia; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 218.272 is hereby amended to read as follows:

218.272 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, the fiscal analysis division shall obtain a fiscal note on:

- (a) Any bill which makes an appropriation or increases any existing appropriation;
- (b) Any bill or joint resolution which creates or increases any fiscal liability or decreases any revenue which appears to be in excess of \$2,000; and
- (c) Any bill or joint resolution which increases or newly provides for a term of imprisonment in the state prison or makes release on parole or probation from the state prison less likely,
- 12 before a vote is taken on such a bill or joint resolution by a committee of the assembly or the senate.
 - 2. The fiscal note must contain a reliable estimate of the anticipated change in appropriation authority, fiscal liability or state revenue under the bill or joint resolution [. including.] for the next two biennia and, to the extent possible, a projection of such changes in future biennia.

- 3. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 218.272 to 218.2758, inclusive, or in the joint rules of the senate and assembly, the estimates must be made by the agency receiving the appropriation or collecting the revenue.
- 5 4. The fiscal note is not required on any bill or joint resolution relating 6 exclusively to the proposed executive budget.
