AN ACT relating to education; making appropriations to the Clark County School District for the expansion of programs to provide distance education and for the related conversion to digital television; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used for the production and distribution of programming and media on a statewide basis to provide distance education for:
 - (a) Pupils who demonstrate a high-risk of dropping out of school; and
- (b) Employees of school districts and employees of this state in areas of training devoted to improving their professional performance.
- 3. Any balance of the sums appropriated by subsection 1 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal years and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
