AN ACT making an appropriation to the Office of Diversity Initiatives of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for the support of a pilot program to increase the number of economically disadvantaged persons who complete 4-year college degrees; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Office of Diversity Initiatives of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, the sum of \$200,000 for the support of a pilot program, based on, but expanding the scope of, Arizona's "Hispanic Mother-Daughter Program," to increase the number of economically disadvantaged men and women who complete a 4-year college degree.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
