AN ACT making an appropriation to Clark County for expenses related to the establishment and support of a regional shooting range in Southern Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to Clark County for expenses related to the establishment and support of a regional shooting range in Southern Nevada:

For fiscal year 2001-2002	\$500,000
For fiscal year 2002-2003	\$500,000

Sec. 2. The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are available for either fiscal year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
