THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 235.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
235.070 The animal known as the desert bighorn sheep (Ovis canadensis nelsoni) [is] and the wild horse known as the mustang (Equus caballus) are hereby designated as the official state [animal] animals of the State of Nevada.
